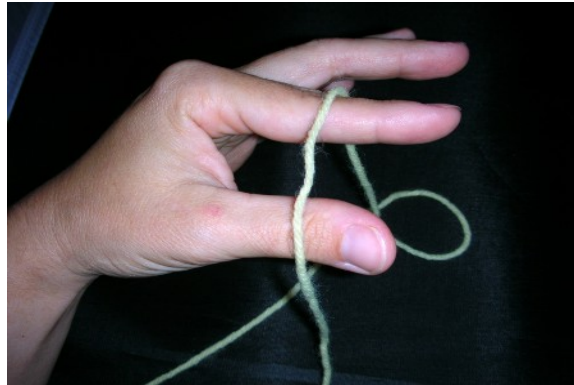

### Making a Slip Knot



There are several ways out there to make a slip knot. Any way you do it you want your end result to be the same. You want to be able to pull on the tail end of the yarn in order to loosen the knot and the working end of the yarn to tighten the knot. Here is the method that I most like to use to make a slip knot:



- Hold your thumb and index finger slightly apart.
- Drape the yarn over your fingers with the tail end of the yarn towards you.



- Rotate your fingers around counterclockwise twisting the yarn.
- Grab the working end of your yarn between your two fingers and pull it through the loop over your fingers.



- Pull on the working end of the yarn to tighten up your slip knot.
